- Applicant must be newly enrolled or returning student in a certificate, diploma or degree program at Booth UC
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need
- Applicant must be enrolled in no less than 12 credit hours per term
- Applicant must be a Salvationist in good standing from a Salvation Army African Territory
- Applicant must provide a recommendation form from their Corps Officer by having them complete the “Salvation Army Corps Officer Recommendation” form (*page 3 of this application*)
- Applicant must provide budgetary information
- Applicant must provide a personal explanation letter
