In order to be eligible for the above scholarship, students must meet the following criteria/requirements. This is awarded on a competitive basis and to be credited towards tuition.

- Applicant must be newly enrolled in a degree program at Booth UC, in the September following graduation from a Canadian high school (regardless of citizenship status), or Canadian citizen graduating from an international high school, with a minimum entrance average of 90%
- Applicant must take a minimum of 15 credit hours per term (5 courses)
- Applicant must provide a nomination letter from High School’s Leadership
- Applicant must provide three letters of reference
- Applicant must provide a resume outlining areas of community service
- Applicant must provide a 250-word essay providing details of community service
