## **Sessional Instructor**

### **Chaplaincy & Spiritual Care Certificate Program (School for Continuing Studies)**

The School for Continuing Studies at Booth University College equips diverse adult learners with career related knowledge and skills that are designed to focus on real-world applications. Courses are offered in a flexible online asynchronous delivery mode, enabling learners to fit their education with other personal life commitments. Course instructors are expected to monitor student progress and check in weekly via the online learning management system to ensure students are progressing successfully through course lessons and materials.

The School for Continuing Studies is currently seeking a Sessional Instructor for the MIN255 Social Services Chaplaincy course. This course offers the opportunity to consider and reflect upon the quality and delivery of spiritual care in a diversity of settings that characterize the social service context. The course includes topics such as the role and identity of the caregiver, addictions, homelessness, grief and loss, mental illness, and cultural issues. The use of themes of Scripture and pastoral practice are central to each topic and the final units are directed towards integration and development of a theology of spiritual care/pastoral care.

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE JOB/ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Sessional Instructors in the Chaplaincy & Spiritual Care Program are responsible to guide student progress through course curriculum that has been designed to cover learning outcomes of a 3-credit hour course.

This includes:

- Introduce themselves and the course to enrolled students
- Facilitate topical discussions as required by curriculum
- Answer student questions related to course material and assignments
- Monitor student progress and reach out to students who are not progressing as expected
- Evaluate student performance on assignments and tests
- Upload student grades to the Student Information System
