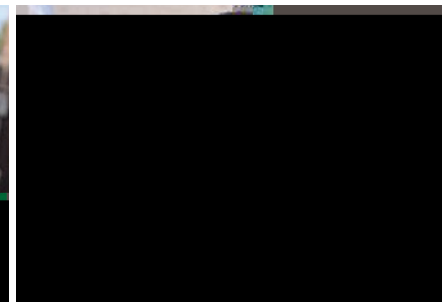
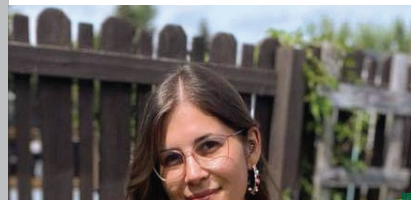
Dear Friends,

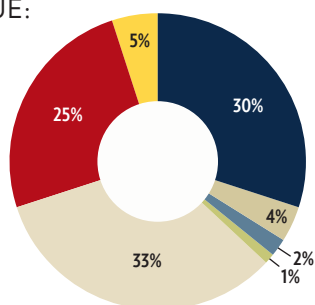

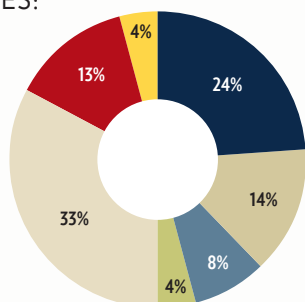
