If you have experienced Sexual Violence

If you have not already done so, you may consider contacting these resources that are available to you in Winnipeg, MB including:

- Sexual Assault Crisis Line at 204-786-8631;
- 24-Hour Crisis Line at 204-786-8686; or
- Sexual Assault Crisis Counselling (by appointment) at 204-786-4049.
- You can report the violence to the **City of Winnipeg Police** emergency line by dialing **911** or the non-emergency line at 204-985-6222.

Booth University College encourages you to contact these resources, however, the cost of these programs, if any, is not covered by Booth University College.

If you would like to file a formal complaint

Formal complaints should be made to the Human Resources Coordinator by completing the "Sexual Violence Report Form" which can be found at <https://www.boothuc.ca/campus-life/student-services/sexual-violence-policy-procedures/>.

Should the Human Resources Coordinator be the object of the complaint, the complaint should be made to the Vice President Administration.

Booth University College reserves the right to initiate an Investigation in accordance with this Policy, and/or to report the incident to local police services, even without the consent of the complainant, if it believes that the safety of those at Booth University College is at risk or if the reporting is required by law

The Booth University College Sexual Violence Committee will investigate the situation and provide findings.
