RE: SALVATIONIST AWARDS AT BOOTH UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

Booth University College has student scholarships available to Salvationists. You have received this letter and form, as a student from your congregation has applied and will be attending Booth University College during the next intake and is eligible for one or more of the following:

Canada and Bermuda Territory Salvationist Award (*Renewable for 2nd year*)

To receive the award, a student must be from a Corps in the Canada and Bermuda Territory, enrolled a minimum of 12 credit hours per term and must continue to be a Salvationist in good standing (ie be attending a Salvation Army Corps while a student at Booth UC). Full criteria at BoothUC.ca/scholarships.

Salvation Army Students - Residence Bonus (*Renewable*)

To receive the award a student must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours at Booth University College, must continue to be a Salvationist in good standing (ie be attending a Salvation Army Corps while a student at Booth UC), and must be in good standing in a program. Full criteria at BoothUC.ca/scholarships.

Salvation Army Students - Tuition Incentive (*Renewable*)

To receive the award a student must enrolled full time at Booth University College, must continue to be a Salvationist in good standing (ie be attending a Salvation Army corps while a student at Booth UC), and must maintain a CGPA of 2.7 or higher. Full criteria at BoothUC.ca/scholarships

Salvation Army Students - Abara Scholarship (*Renewable*)

To receive the award a student must be from an African Salvation Army Territory taking a minimum of 12 credit hours per term, have demonstrated financial need and must be a Salvationist in good standing. Full criteria at BoothUC.ca/scholarships

Your recommendation is one of the criteria required to release these scholarships to the incoming student. Thank you for your recommendation! In order for the scholarships to be renewed we will be asking the corps officers of the chosen Winnipeg corps to do the same. We have informed the students of this and they are aware that in order to be eligible for their scholarships each year all criteria must be met including being a Salvationist in good standing.
